## IN CONVERSATION with J.P. Pomare

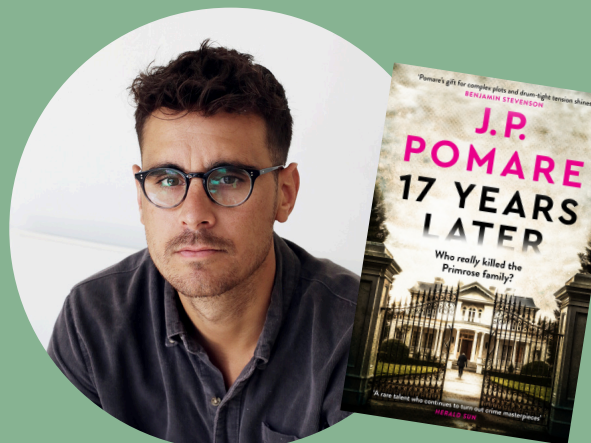
**Thursday 29 August 5.30 pm**
