In Conversation with Kerry Mayne

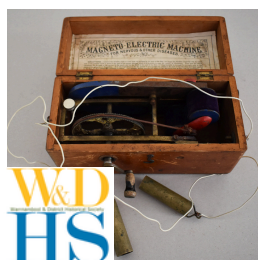
Thursday 30 May at 6.30 pm
