## RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Unpublished writers are defined as those writers who have not had a novel, or collection of short stories commercially published

For the purposes of this program the Warrnambool district includes: Areas within the boundaries of Warrnambool City, Dennington, Allansford, and Woodford

Entrants must be aged 15+

Entrant name or identifiers are not to appear anywhere on the work submitted for consideration.

The submitted work must be the authors own work and not breach the copyright of others.

The submitted work must not have been previously published in its current form.

The submitted work must be within the accepted word limit.

The submitted work must be 12point standard font such as Calibri or Times New Roman and 1.5 line-spaced

Successful entrants agree to either reading their work, or having their work read for them, at a Warrnambool Library event such as the regular Literary Lounge series.

Submissions that do not abide by the Rules and Regulations as outlined here will be removed from the judging process
