Looking to meet other avid readers and casually chat all things books and reading? We have the group for you! Come along to our library-ran book chat on the second Wednesday of every month.

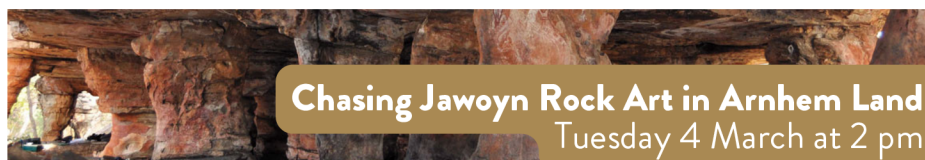
